Devotions and Traditions

Looking for ways to honor our spiritual father? We've included several popular devotions and traditions to grow in love for St. Joseph:

- Wednesday and March Dedication
 - The Holy Mother Church, has dedicated each Wednesday and month of March to St. Joseph. This is the optimal time to reflect on, be grateful for, and intercede on behalf of holy fatherhood, both spiritually and biologically.
- Novena Prayers
 - Recite a daily novena prayer in praise of St. Joseph's virtues and to obtain his blessing for a special intention.
- Seven Sundays Devotion
 - Receive Holy Communion on seven consecutive Sundays while offering prayers in honor of St. Joseph's seven joys and seven sorrows.
- 33 Day St. Joseph Consecration
 - Go to Jesus through Mary, as modeled by St. Joseph. Consecrate yourself to the protective care of St. Joseph, Head of the Holy Family.
- St. Joseph's Table (altar)
 - Within your home, create a makeshift shrine/dinner festival and gather/make food to share with those who are less fortunate. This could mean donating food to a local shelter or food bank.
- Holy Spouses Rosary and St. Joseph Rosary

Plenary Indulgences for the Year of Saint Joseph

To commemorate the Year of Saint Joseph, the Pope has extended the opportunity for the faithful, detached from sin, to obtain a plenary indulgence through their participation in at least one of the following:

- Meditate for at least 30 minutes on the Our Father
- Go on a spiritual retreat, for at least one day, that includes a meditation on St. Joseph
- Perform a corporal or spiritual work of mercy
- Recite the Holy Rosary in families and between the husband and wife
- Entrust daily activity and work to the protection of Saint Joseph and invoke the intercession of St. Joseph the Worker
- Recite the litany of St. Joseph for all persecuted persecuted Christians
- Pray any legitimately approved prayer, or act of piety, in honor of St. Joseph, especially on:
 - Solemnity of St. Joseph (March 19th), Feast of St. Joseph the Worker (May 1st), Feast of the Holy Family (December 26th), 19th of every month, every Wednesday (day dedicated to St. Joseph)
